Subject: Willingness of CBIC Inspectors for posting in Ad.IIIB on loan basis- Regarding

Sir/Madam,

AD III B section of CBIC deals with work relating to Recruitment Rules, communication of DR vacancies to SSC, Zonal allocation of candidates allotted to CBIC by SSC, etc relating to Group B Non Gazetted and Group C cadres. In view of acute staff shortage in the section, applications of willing officers (CBIC Inspectors) are invited for posting in Ad.IIIB on loan basis. The period of loan is initially for two years and can be further extended for one year at the discretion of the competent authority with the concurrence of the cadre controlling authority concerned. Further, as per Board F.No. A-11013/12/2019-Ad.IV dated 27.05.2020, in exceptional circumstances, for justifiable reasons, Board may extend the tenure of the officers beyond 3 years.

2. Applications of interested officers may be forwarded by CCAs to the Under Secretary, Ad.IIIB along with History of Posting, APAR grading up to the previous 3 years, Vigilance Clearance Certificate and "No Objection Certificate" from the concerned CCA **latest by 06.05.2022**. All the applicants are required to apply through proper channel only.

3. The candidates shall be selected on the basis of right aptitude, APAR gradings and the work experience. Preference would be given to candidates who have worked in Establishment Branch and have good command over noting and drafting.

4. In case, while working in Ad.IIIB, the work and conduct of the officer is not found to be satisfactory, the officer can be reverted to the parent Commissionerate before completion of the loan period.

5. CCAs are requested to circulate this letter among stakeholders on priority and forward proposals to AD III B at the earliest.
