1. The firm/person, who are interested to buy all the above condemned vehicles, have to submit their highest Bid online through e-procurement portal <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> only. Tender sent by any other mode will not be considered and the same will be rejected summarily. All the documents in support of eligibility criteria etc. are also required to be scanned and uploaded along with the Tender document within the prescribed time limit. No tender document will be accepted after the expiry of stipulated date and time for the purpose under any circumstances what so ever.
2. The bidder may submit an Earnest Money of ₹10,000/- by way of Demand Draft in favour of "RBI A/C Commissioner of Customs, Kolkata" within the prescribed time limit to the SCP, Disposal Cell (AP & ACC) (Mobile No. 9831316838, 9903280488). **The details of the same should also be furnished in the proforma specified as ANNEXURE-I.**
3. Before submission of tender, the condition of the vehicles can be inspected physically between 11:00AM to 3:00 PM on any working day at Office of the Principal Commissioner of Customs, Airport & ACC Commissionerate, Custom House, 15/1 Strand Road, Kolkata – 700 001. For any queries regarding inspection of the vehicles, the following authority may be contacted: Superintendent of Customs, MTO (Mob.: 9734866609), Custom House, 15/1 Strand Road, Kolkata700001.
4. All entries should be legible and filled clearly, if the space provided for furnishing information is insufficient; a separate sheet duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory may be scanned and uploaded. No correction in the BID is permitted.
5. No Bidder firm/person will be allowed to withdraw its bid after opening of bids.
6. The auction will be governed by enclosed terms and conditions.

TERMS AND CONDITION FOR SALE OF CONDEMNED GOVT. VEHICLES

1. The disposal of vehicles shall be strictly on "AS IS WHERE IS AND WHATEVER IS BASIS" and no guarantee or certificate of its worthiness or quality will be given by the Department.
2. E-Tender is invited in two parts i.e. (1) Technical Bid (2) Financial Bid. The e- Tender for Technical Bid in proforma prescribed in ANNEXURE - I and the e-tender form for the Financial Bid, the tenderer may quote their FINANCIAL BID complete on e-procurement website i.e. www.eprocure.gov.in by enrolling himself on the said website. Incomplete bid documents shall be rejected. The valid Technical bids shall be scrutinized by this office to short list the eligible bidders. Thereafter, the Financial Bids of the shortlisted bidders who have qualified in Technical Bid will be opened.
3. Bidders need to submit earnest money for ₹10,000/-. The earnest money can be deposited by Demand Draft in favor of "**RBI A/C Commissioner of Customs, Kolkata**". The Demand Draft should also be uploaded along with all the relevant documents, failing which the bids will not be considered at all. If the highest Bidder/successful Bidder fails to deposit the sale price within the prescribed time limit, his earnest money will be forfeited. In case, the offer is withdrawn by any tenderer, the earnest money deposited by him shall be forfeited.
4. Offers received without EMD amount shall not be considered at all by this Department.
5. The bidder shall quote a single amount for all 05 vehicles excluding GST in prescribed Financial Bid.
6. The successful Bidder will be required to deposit the total bid amount excluding GST & all other tax applicable at time by means of DD/ Payorder/ Banker's Cheque in favour of "RBI A/C Commissioner of Customs, Kolkata" within five working days after receiving letter from the department in this regard.
7. The successful Bidder will also be required to deposit the GST/other applicable Tax against the successful Bid amount **on reverse charge basis** as per extant Rule.
8. EMD of the successful bidder(s) will be released only after realization of sale proceeds of vehicles. EMD of the bidders who fail to honor the bid in prescribed time limit shall stand forfeited. No representation in this regard shall be entertained by this department. EMD amount will not be adjusted in the sale amount accepted by Bank.
9. The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status (Ration Card/ Voters identity Card/ Aadhaar Card/ Passport in case of individual and Trade License/Registration Certificate in case of firms) and PAN Card/TAN Card.
10. The sold vehicle will be removed by the successful bidder at their own expenses and arrangements. No assistance/ transportation will be provided by the department. Permission to take out the disposed vehicles from the premises will be allowed only on working days.
11. Sale letter will be executed in favor of the Successful Bidder on depositing the entire sale consideration and production of GST Receipt paid on reverse charge basis.
12. EMD of the firms rescinding their offer, withdrawing or abrogating after submitting the bid shall stand forfeited. Decision of the department shall be final in this regard.
13. The department reserves the right to reject all or any tender in whole or part without assigning any reasons thereof.
14. EMD of unsuccessful tenders shall be returned within three weeks of the award of contract to successful party.
15. The tenderer shall sign and stamp each page of this tender document and all other

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enclosures appended to it as a token of having read and understood the terms and conditions contained therein and submit the same along with the Technical Bid. The tenderer would fill up the information in the Annexure I enclosed at the end of these documents in clear and legible terms. Annexure-I shall also have to be signed and stamped by the bidder or his authorized signatory. The bidder is required to reveal his full name/ name of the authorized signatory of the firm, name of father, full postal address, telephone number and mobile number.

16. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to jurisdiction in Court of Kolkata only.
17. If the highest quoting person/firms fail to honor the bid, contract will be cancelled and its EMD will be forfeited.
18. Tendering forms should be signed in ink by the authorized signatory only. Photocopy or unsigned or not signed by authorized signatory shall be rejected.
19. Tendering firms shall alone be responsible for furnishing any false or wrong information and the consequences or loss thereof.
20. The evaluation of the Bid will be done on the basis of all five condemned vehicles excluding all leviable taxes. However, the bid quoted should not be less than the rate fixed by the authority in any case.
21. The vehicle must be scrapped by the successful bidder.
22. The vehicle identification plate (the one that has the engine and chassis numbers engraved on it, successful bidder might need someone to use a blowtorch and cut it out with its surrounding metal) shall be removed and handed over to the competent authority before taking away the vehicle(s).
23. Final decision to accept/reject the bids shall be taken up by the Competent Authority i.e. Joint Commissioner (Airport & ACC), Custom House, Kolkata.
