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Dear Director General,

Since September 2018, the Working Group of the Comprehensive review on the Revised Kyoto Convention (WGRKC) has held seven meetings and has intensively discussed over 170 proposals relating to 36 concepts submitted by Members and external stakeholders.

In February 2020, the 22nd RKC/Management Committee (MC) decided to continue the RKC review process under a “four-step framework” within the RKC/MC after the 8th and final meeting of the WGRKC takes place. To date, the review has been carried out with the support of experienced WCO staff with knowledge of the existing RKC and the requirements necessary to bring the Convention in line with modern Trade and Customs procedures and practices.

I am writing to request your support with sharing with members of your Administration this vacancy notice for a short-term contractor position funded from the WCO Reserves, to assist in continuing the Review of the RKC as the post will be vacated from September 2020. Candidates must have an excellent knowledge of the RKC and Customs procedures, including automated procedures and the use of automation in Customs.

The contract offered to the successful candidate will include a salary equivalent to that of a Technical Officer (Grade A3 step 1). The person appointed will be included in the WCO medical insurance scheme. However, no other allowances will apply. The successful candidate will be assisted with a visa application, if necessary.

The candidate should be fluent in either English or French, with a good knowledge of the other language.

Should a member of your administration be interested in this position, he/she is kindly invited to apply by **Tuesday, 15 September 2020**, following the procedure indicated in the attached vacancy notice.
