Sub: - Preparation of panel of vacancies/anticipated vacancies of Group 'B' (Gazetted & Non-Gazetted) officers – reg.

Sir/Madam,

It has been decided to draw a panel of suitable and eligible officers, to strengthen the working of Vigilance Section, for the following posts on **deputation / loan basis**.

S. No.	Designation	Pay Matrix level no. (Acc. To 7th Pay Commission)
1.	Superintendent	Level 8 (Grade Pay 4800)
2.	Inspector	Level 7 (Grade Pay 4600)

2. These posts are to be filled up on deputation and loan basis by drawing suitable officers in the grade of Superintendent, Inspector of Indirect Tax, Service Tax and Customs from amongst the officers holding analogous posts in the Commissionerates/Directorates under CBIC in the same pay scale. The age of the officer shall not exceed 55 years as on closing date of this circular.

3. Such officers selected would normally be taken on deputation / loan basis for a period not exceeding 3 years.

4. It is requested that applications of the interested and eligible officers may be forwarded to the **Principal Additional Director General, Directorate General of Vigilance (Hqrs.), Hotel Samrat, New Delhi** along with their vigilance clearance with their particulars viz. Name, address, education qualification, date of birth, history of posting, present post & the date from which it is held, scale of pay, experience along with synopsis of their ACR grading of the last 5 years and "No Objection Certificate" from the concerned Commissionerate/Directorate General latest by **09.03.2020**. It may also be brought to the notice of the willing officers that once they are selected, they will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature. It may also be certified that no vigilance case is pending or being contemplated against any such officer.

5. Applications shall be forwarded by the Chief Commissioner, who shall shortlist officers having good command over English language with essential Noting and Drafting skills required to work in the Vigilance section.


6. In case, while working in the DGoV, conduct of the officer is not found to be satisfactory the officer shall be reverted to the parent Commissionerate/Directorate before completion of the tenure without assigning any reasons.

7. It is requested that this letter may be widely circulated among the officers under your jurisdiction and officers with an aptitude to work in Vigilance be identified and encouraged to apply for these posts.
