2.0 The interests service providers who comply with terms and conditions of this tender are requested to submit their tenders online as per the below mentioned time schedule. The pro-forma for the bid is prescribed in Annexure – I of this tender. Annexure – II contains broad layout of the work site.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Terms and Conditions for the Tender Notice Inviting Online-Tender for Construction of Compound Wall and a Main Gate for Central Tax (GST) Staff Quarters, Tirupati are as follows:

1. The Contract includes two parts as mentioned below:

(i) **Part 1:** Construction of Compound wall with Barbed Wire on top of the wall, towards the North side of Central Tax (GST) Staff Quarters, Tirupati. The specifications are as follows:

a. **Compound wall:**

- i. Length: 115 feet (Apprx.).
- ii. Thickness: Minimum 1 foot.
- iii. Height: Minimum 5 feet.
- iv. Columns – 12 Nos. with 3 ½ X 3 ½ X 3 feet (Length, Breadth and Depth). Steel used for the column shall be minimum 12 mm.
- v. Footing for the column shall be made using 8 mm Steel.
- vi. Wall is to be built with Flyash bricks of size 12 X 8 X 6 (Inches) with two sides plastering, whitewash and painting.

b. **Barbed wire:** 4 lines with minimum 4 feet height (1/2 feet inside wall and 3 ½ feet over the wall).

- (ii) **Part 2:** Construction of Iron Gate structure (2 Gates) with Department name and Emblem on front side of the Gates. The specifications are as follows:
- a. Length of Gates – 6 ½ feet each i.e., a total of 13 feet for two gates together.
 - b. Height of Gates – 6 feet each.
 - c. Supporting RCC Column for the Gate – Two in No. with 14 X 9 X 36 X 84 Inches dimensions (Length, breadth, depth and height).
 - d. 18 Gauge, 3 feet height sheet at bottom of the Gate to write department name and emblem.
2. Compound wall and the Gate structure mentioned above should be painted with appropriate color and the colour will be decided by this office in due course.
 3. This is a single bid system, where the bidder shall submit their tender in one cover (Annexure-I) only through online mode, which includes, personal details, items wise cost of the materials to be used for the project and overall cost of the project.
 4. Only bids submitted online through e-procurement portal shall be considered for evaluation; bids submitted through physical mode shall not be entertained.
 5. Bidder shall physically inspect the work site and submit their willingness along with drawings/specifications for the project before submitting their bids.
 6. Broad layout of the work site is provided in Annexure 2 to the tender for reference.
 7. Price quoted shall be an all-inclusive price i.e., (all taxes, materials, labour etc.).
 8. The Contractor shall abide by all the rules and regulations related to concerned laws with respect to the workmen employed by him; this will be the sole responsibility of the contractor. This office will not be party at any stage in any of the disputes relating to the above. In case, this office has to bear any expenditure due to non-conformance of the above provisions by the contractor, the same will be recovered from contractor's bill.
 9. The contractor's employees/workmen working at the work site will strictly abide all the rules and regulations as and when instructed. Any damage to the property due to mishandling, carelessness on the contractor's or his workmen's part will be recovered from the contractor's bill. Contractor should supervise; monitor the work on regular basis. Manpower deployed by the contractor at our site for carrying out contract works is strictly prohibited from being associated with any other works at the site.
 10. The contractor will arrange all necessary material, tools, equipment, working consumables etc., need for execution of the works. Safe custody of all such materials will be contractor's sole responsibility. No extra charges will be paid for the same. Watch and ward of all material till the work is completed shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

11. During execution of the work, contractor should dispose of waste material and should keep the site properly, neat and clean as far as possible. After completion of the work, the contractor should clear the site completely of all the unwanted and junk material, debris before submitting the bill.
12. During execution of work, the contractor should follow all standard norms of safety measures/precautions as per relevant safety standards and specifications to avoid accidents/damage to man, machines and buildings at his own cost. Contractor will have his own arrangements to escort the labor to the nearest hospital for treatment and should bear all the medical expenses in case of injury happening to any worker during execution of work. It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to ensure safety of their labour at the work site.
13. The due date for completion of the project in all respects is 15.03.2021. If the project is not completed by the due date, the bill submitted by the contractor will not be sanctioned.
14. The payment shall be made after submission of bill by the contractor and duly certified by the completion authority to their satisfaction of the work carried out by the contractor.
15. The contractor shall abide by the norms and terms till the completion of the contract.
